3. Decorate your pumpkin! Paint and embellish the pumpkin but if it is real you CANNOT carve, cut, slice, gut, etc. We don't want any rotting gourds. No hazardous materials/objects can be used as decorations. We will not accept real pumpkins that have been cut, carved, sliced, or gutted.

4. Complete the form (below) and turn it in with your pumpkin.


Judging & Prizes

Pumpkins will be accepted from Wednesday, October 16th through Friday, October 18th. Drop off your pumpkin and entry form at the library during normal business hours.

IMPORTANT: All pumpkins will be displayed at the library from Oct. 21st - Oct. 31st. Winning pumpkins will be announced on Oct. 25th. All pumpkins MUST be picked up by Saturday, Nov. 2nd, or they will be disposed of.
